- Margins: top, bottom-15 mm each, right and left -25 mm each
- Title 14 pt, Times New Roman Bold
- Authors 12 pt, Times New Roman Bold
- Affiliation 9 pt. Times New Roman
- Abstract (200-250 words) in 10 pt. Times New Roman Italic
- Main text in 11 pt. Times New Roman, line spacing: single
- Chapter titles 12 pt, Times New Roman, Uppercase.
- Subtitles 11 pt, Times New Roman
- Tables or pictures should be labeled in logical order
- Emphasize contributions and results
- · Include labeled references
